Also, the existing shortcomings systemic in Resolution of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated September 9, 2017 No PP-3261 "On measures to radically improve the system of preschool education", the full implementation of state policy in the field of preschool education The reasons that prevent the increase are specified, in particular:

✓ First, the current state of preschool education management does not allow for

- the timely identification and elimination of systemic problems, the development and introduction of modern innovative technologies in this area, including in the nongovernmental sector;
- ✓ Secondly, there are no publicprivate partnership mechanisms aimed at attracting investment in preschool education. including the establishment of socially popular preschool educational institutions, their material and technical re-equipment and the use of advanced pedagogical technologies;
- ✓ Thirdly, the current state of the infrastructure and material and technical base of pre-school education institutions does not allow to ensure full coverage of children with pre-school education institutions. 'leads to lib;
- Fourthly, the preparation of educational-methodical, didactic (including games and toys) materials and fiction, reflecting the national cultural and historical values and arousing interest in reading from childhood, as well as preschool education. the introduction of educational

- institutions does not meet modern requirements;
- ✓ Fifth, the current system of training and retraining does not provide the field of preschool education with highly qualified specialists who are able to professionally address issues of child rearing and comprehensive development;
- ✓ Sixth, the low level of the system of financial incentives for employees of preschool education institutions does not allow to attract qualified personnel;
- ✓ Seventh, shortcomings in the organization of the work of regional health authorities in the provision of medical children services to in preschool education are aimed at protecting the life and health of children, including ensuring a healthy diet. This leads to a decrease in the effectiveness of preventive measures.

According to the resolution, a commission was established to critically study and develop proposals for further improvement of the preschool education system, and its main tasks include:

• revision of state requirements for the organization of quality preschool education, taking into account the best

- international experience in the field of harmonious development of preschool children;
- Introduction of a simplified procedure for licensing the activities non-governmental preschool educational institutions, the study of existing practices and best international practices, the preparation proposals improve to their organizational and legal forms. Further expansion of the state and non-state network of preschool educational institutions, creation of conditions for creating a healthy environment competitive between public and non-state preschool educational institutions, introduction of new forms of preschool educational institutions in public-private partnership, as well as In order to ensure the effective organization of the Ministry of Preschool Education of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the President of Republic the of Uzbekistan dated September 30, 2017 No PP-3305 "On the organization of the Ministry of Preschool Education of the Republic of Uzbekistan" The decision was made. As noted in the commentary to this decision: "... the of today issue radical improvement of preschool education, increasing the coverage of preschool children, the creation of a modern system in all respects, studying the

As noted in the Decree of the President of the Republic Uzbekistan dated September 30, 2017 No PF-5198 "On measures radically improve the management of the preschool education system", "Preschool education is the primary system of continuing education. It is very important in the upbringing of a healthy and well-rounded child and his preparation for school.

During the years of independence, the education system in the country and the upbringing of a harmoniously developed generation has risen to the level of the main priorities of state policy.

However, the analysis shows that the effectiveness and results of the work carried out in the field of preschool education are insufficient.

In order to further improve the system of preschool education, which is an important part of the system of continuing education, in accordance with this resolution, the Ministry of Preschool Education of the Republic Uzbekistan. the Ministry Preschool Education of the Republic of Karakalpakstan. The task was set to establish the main department of education, regional departments of preschool education and their district (city) branches. Along with the main tasks and activities of the Ministry of Preschool Education of the Republic of Uzbekistan, its territorial divisions, it is planned to create conditions for the comprehensive intellectual, moral, aesthetic and physical development of preschool children, taking into account best international practices. .

The structure of Russian education curricula and consists of standards and directions of various levels, as well as governing bodies outside the institutions education subordinated system and to education system. Preschool education is the first stage of the education system.

Today, educational standards are set out in the International Convention on the Rights of the Child, which states: children should have the opportunity to attend educational institutions;

regulations, children's educational institutions are divided into five types:

- Kindergartens, which consider it important to implement one or two directions of development;
- Kindergartens of compensatory type, aimed at the qualified correction of children with mental disorders;
- Kindergartens under the supervision of educators, where health exercises are conducted with children:
- Kindergartens with a variety of general development, rehabilitation and compensatory groups on their territory;
- Early childhood development centers - kindergartens where children can recover, acquire new knowledge and skills, receive spiritual support.

Thus, the preschool education system is characterized by multifunctionality, colorful planning, priority development direction, and freedom to identify different programming.

We hope that all the ongoing reforms will be reflected in practice, and our children will be provided with quality pre-school education, and teachers - with decent wages and benefits.
